

IT WAS a sight that had even the hoariest fishermen fleeing for port: hundreds of giant basking sharks congregating in shoals off the Cornish

While some fled, others took advantage of the unprecedented gathering and ferried sightseers out to watch the enormous 50ft long sharks as they lay on the surface, fins clearly visible.

Marine scientists admitted

they were baffled as to why the world's second largest fish had chosen to return in such numbers after years of gradual decline.

THE CANVASS

To keep the electoral register up to date each year we conduct a canvass by sending registration forms or visiting all households during September/October.

You are required by law to complete the form or assist the canvasser by giving details of every person, who will be living in the household on October 10, who is eligible to vote. If nobody is eligible you must still complete the form and return it to the Electoral Registration Officer, or advise the canvasser of the circumstances. Failure to supply the information can result in a fine of up to £1,000.

A SHOE designer is being charged £1,000 for water although her shop has no tap.

But South West Water, which has the highest rates in the country, has told her that unless she has to "cross a public highway" she cannot borrow a bathroom for free. They have sent her a bill for £1,036.55 to cover from last August to the end of this year.

The car firm, Albert's Private Hire, say they have paid their water rates in full already. Mrs Ongaro said: "This is farcical."

A spokesman for South West Water said: "This is a legitimate bill. There are associated charges involved. We are following industry-wide guidelines. If you are using a water supply, even if it is not your own, you must pay."

Goldwell Colorance Colour Styling Mousse, £4.50, 20 shades (01323 521521 for stockists) You use this like you would a styling mousse. The colour was so muted it hardly showed, but at least it washed out easily.

Wella Shaders/Toners, 99p, 10 shades The small sachet didn't seem enough



for my long hair, but it lathered up well. As it looked such a scary colour, I rinsed it out after only eight minutes, half expecting to look like Ginger Spice. But the result was so subtle, it only really showed in daylight. A good introduction to colour.

Alberto VO5 Colour Mousse, £3.69, 10 shades



This mousse was quite sticky and difficult to handle. I scrunched it in after washing, but once my hair was blow-dried the colour effect was so weedy I could hardly see it. It also made my hair stiff and dry.

Inecto Hint of a Tint, 89p, 9 shades
This liquid was a bit messy to use.
I left it on my hair for 10 minutes and
the results were good—soft, well-

conditioned hair and a nice colour lift. But it was a bit of a hassle!
